The use of oxygen during conventional CPR has been advocated for decades to decrease the effects of anoxia on the brain. Paired with an AED you have the best of both worlds. The new CPR guidelines that emphasize only chest compressions is ideal for the Oxysure model 615; the mask can be applied after the unit is started and the compressions will not only circulate the blood but will provide an oxygen rich involuntary respiration. This of course has application for the "untrained" resuscitator as well as the medical professional.
